



## Notice of Draft REA Reports Public Review and Notice of Final Public Meeting by Grand Bend Wind Limited Partnership c/o Northland Power Inc. to Engage in a Renewable Energy Project

Project Name: Grand Bend Wind Farm

Project Location: North of Grand Bend, in the Municipalities of Bluewater and South Huron, in Huron County.

Portions of the transmission line also traverse the Municipality of Huron East in the County of

Huron and Municipality of West Perth, in the County of Perth.

Dated at: West Perth, South Huron, Bluewater and Huron East this 26<sup>th</sup> of September, 2012

Grand Bend Wind Limited Partnership c/o Northland Power Inc. is planning to engage in a renewable energy Project in respect of which the issuance of a renewable energy approval is required. The proposal to engage in the Project and the Project itself are subject to the provisions of the *Environmental Protection Act* ("Act") Part V.0.1 and Ontario Regulation 359/09 ("Regulation"). This notice must be distributed in accordance with Section 15 of the Regulation prior to an application being submitted and assessed for completeness by the Ministry of the Environment.

The first Public Information Centres (PIC#1), under the Renewable Energy Approvals (REA) process, were held in April 2012. Background data, the study area (including two options for the proposed transmission line) and studies to date were presented.
